Amen.

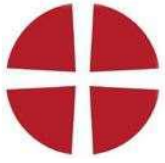
ECO Friendly Tips

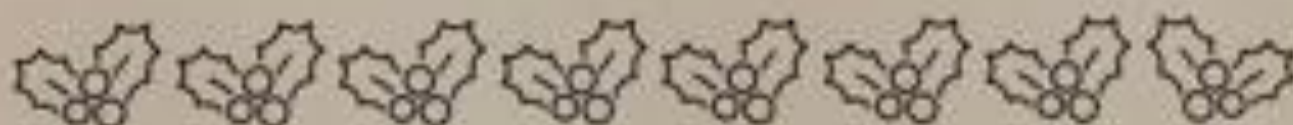

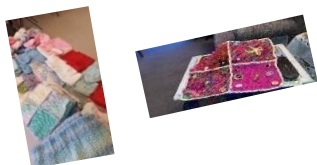

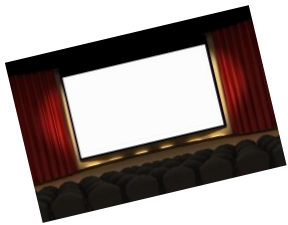
